

## Councillors Initiative Fund [ CIF] allocations for 2011 /12

£4k was allocated to all 37 councillors [\*£148k] to be distributed to Community Groups across the District. Cllr Howitt-Cowan was able to allocate his £4k to worthy causes.

*\*{There was an underspend of over £10k at the end of the two year cycle and this was distributed on a first come first served basis. It was oversubscribed! }*

Five out of the nine communities benefitted from CIF. In addition, several were successful in their applications to the Community Chest.

\*Churches qualify if they can prove Community Use

The **Community Chest** awards max of £500, which may be applied for community projects, in addition to the CIF, and may be re applied for, after 6 months.
