

Recently the Hemswell Ward has been subjected to two substantial wind farm projects, namely;

Proposed Hemswell Cliff Wind Farm

This application submitted by RWE was rejected by WLDC at the Planning Meeting held at the Epic Centre on the Lincolnshire Show Ground.

The Planning Application went to a Public Enquiry which was held early in 2015 & it was called in by the Minister of Local Government & Communities, the outcome of which we anticipate mid June on 2015.

VOCAT formed of the local communities has campaigned against the proposed development and was pro active at the Public Enquiry with WLDC against the wind farm.

The Brown Holt Wind Farm, in Corringham Parish.

The Planning Application has been made by RES.

The Site is within the NE of Corringham Parish bordering onto Willoughton, north of Yawthorpe, a hamlet of Corringham

The proposed development would comprise a wind farm of eight, three-bladed, horizontal axis wind turbines, each up to 140m maximum height to blade tip, much taller than those proposed at Hemswell Cliff.

The planning application for Brown's Holt Wind Farm was formally registered by West Lindsey District Council in February 2015 and assigned the application number **132109**.

A decision on the application, which may be possibly held at the Epic Centre, on the Lincolnshire Show Ground, is expected in the autumn 2015.

CANCAT is a community based group which is opposed to the proposed development.

Sir Edward Leigh MP, Cllr Lewis Strange County Councillor & the District Councillor, PDJ Howitt-Cowan are opposed to these two proposed developments.
